

It has also made us a trusted global leader working closely with our customers to deliver smarter technology for all.



Through our PSIRT team, Lenovo is also a certified **CVE Numbering Authority (CNA).** That means we are authorized to assign unique Common Vulnerabilities and Exposures (CVE) identification numbers to vulnerabilities affecting Lenovo products, which we share collaboratively with the broader IT community to develop remediation strategies.
