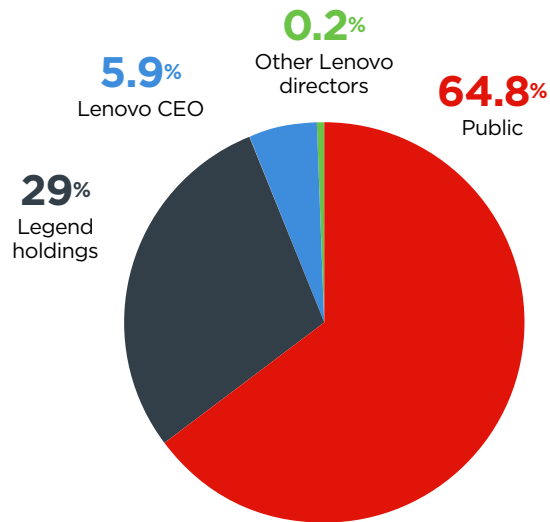

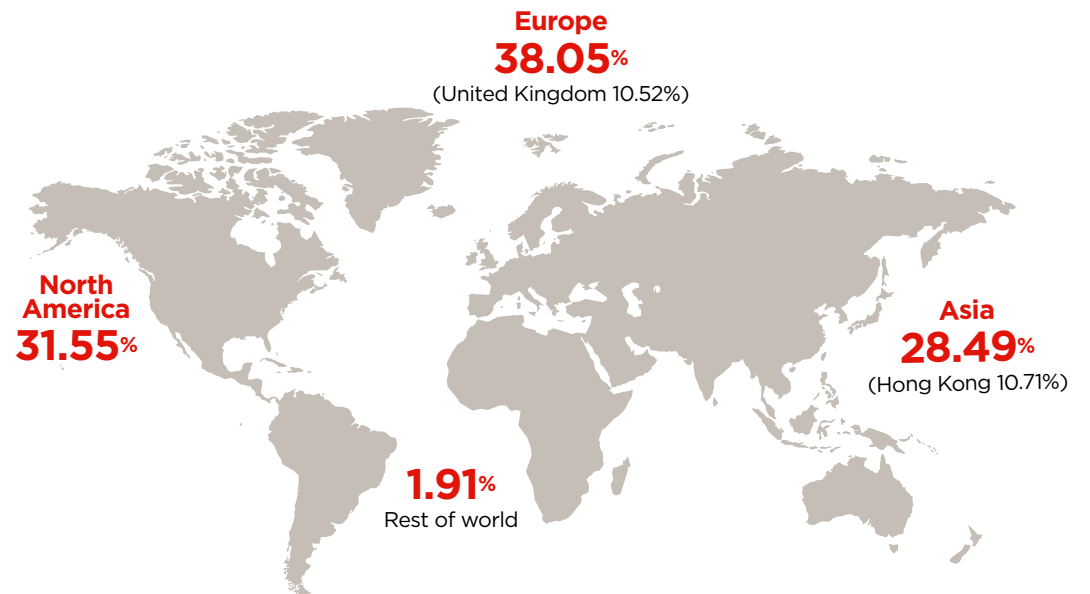

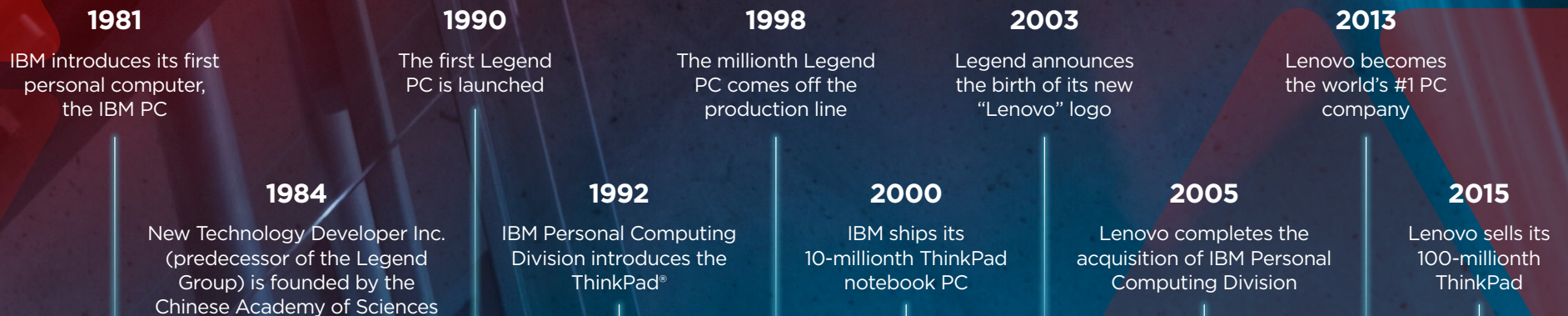

With an ever-changing security threat landscape, new vulnerabilities can be discovered at any time, including after devices have been deployed within a customer's enterprise. That's why Lenovo built a dedicated and robust Product Security Incident Response Team (PSIRT).

Its collaboration with customers, researchers, and our competitors enables the Lenovo PSIRT to proactively provide information to Lenovo customers so they can put mitigation plans in place if a vulnerability that affects Lenovo products is discovered.

Through our PSIRT team, Lenovo is also a certified **CVE Numbering Authority (CNA)**. That means we are authorized to assign unique Common Vulnerabilities and Exposures (CVE) identification numbers to vulnerabilities affecting Lenovo products, which we share collaboratively with the broader IT community to develop remediation strategies.
